Here are the costume expectations for each class:

- Kindergarten: white shirt, black pants or skirts
- 1st Grade: white shirt, black pants or skirts
- 2nd Grade: white OR solid-colored shirt (no designs/writing/logos), black pants
- 3rd Grade: white OR solid-colored shirt (no designs/writing/logos), black pants
- 4th Grade: white shirt, black pants
- 5th Grade: white shirt, black pants
- 6th, 7th, & 8th Grades: white shirt, black pants or skirts

Note: All students in dance performance numbers should have their hair secured from their faces and absolutely no dangling jewelry on during the concert (stud earrings are okay). Pants should allow enough give for students to complete all movements without fear of ripping or exposure. All costumes must comply with the CNH dress code policy. **Students must come prepared to perform on the evening of the concert.**

2017-18 Sibling Enrollment

We are currently accepting enrollment applications for 2017-18. If you wish to enroll a sibling of a current student for 2017-18, you **MUST** complete and submit an enrollment application. If the sibling has a different last name than the current CNH student, please note the current student's name on the application. Applications can be downloaded from our website: www.cityneighborshamilton.org or you can pick up a hard copy in the office during regular school hours. Sibling applications are due by **January 30, 2017.**



Siblings of current students will not be entered into the lottery, however we **MUST** receive an application by the deadline in order to consider him/her for enrollment. Current CNH students do not have to reapply.

Please bear in mind, the definition of sibling is a brother and/or sister who resides in the same household AND:

- shares a common parent, or
- is legally adopted by the same parent, or
- is the legal responsibility of the same adult/parent (proof of legal custody will be required).

Cousins, nieces, nephews, and/or unrelated children sharing the same address with a current CNH student, and who do not meet any of the above criteria, are not considered siblings. The Sibling Preference Policy is dependent upon available grade openings and does not guarantee enrollment for each sibling.

The Sibling Preference Policy applies to current CNH students and does not extend to City Neighbors High School.
