nor Hogan has introduced a budget that includes a \$42 million funding cut to Baltimore City Public Schools. This funding cut will have a DIRECT impact on City Neighbors. The \$42 million funding cut is on top of the BCPSS budget deficit of \$130 million. We need to restore that funding! City Neighbors will join the Baltimore Education Coalition in Annapolis to advocate for the restoration of those funds to Baltimore City Public Schools. To win this battle we must turn





City Neighbors Children Summer Program Beginning two weeks ago, we included in the Monday Mailer applications for the CN summer camp for rising 1st through 4th graders. This summer will be our third summer session at the City Neighbors Hamilton campus. Campers ages 6-10 will enjoy general day camp activities like singing, reading, writing, crafts, and outdoor play as well as dynamic outdoor physical challenges such as bike riding, hiking, new games, riding scooters, and gardening. Nutritious, fresh snacks and lunches will be provided daily to all campers. Visiting artists will lead children in investigations of percussion, puppetry, watercolor painting, and clay sculpture.
