

Inclement Weather Policy Everyone is abuzz about winter storm Stella and the potential for significant snowfall that appears to be headed our way, made all the more exciting--or annoying--by the fact that we almost made it to spring without snow! In light of this forecast, it is time to review our Inclement Weather Policy. The following is excerpted from the School Handbook:

“City Neighbors Hamilton follows the Baltimore City Public Schools inclement weather policy. For information about school closings, delays, and early dismissals, please consult your local television or radio stations.

If Baltimore City Public Schools close, delay opening, or close early due to inclement weather, City Neighbors Hamilton will close, delay opening, or close early for the corresponding amount of time.

In the event school opening is delayed, dismissal will be at the usual time: 3:15 on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, and at 1:00 on Thursdays. For example:

If Baltimore City Public Schools open 2 hours late, then CNH will open at 10:15, including Thursdays and any other “half-days.” In the case of a delayed opening on a Thursday, dismissal will remain the same: 1 PM.

If Baltimore City Public Schools close 2 hours early on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, or Fridays, CNH will close at 1:15. If Baltimore City Public Schools close 2 hours early on a Thursday or any other “half-days”, CNH will dismiss at the usual time: 1 PM.

There will be no aftercare or after-school activities on days when schools are closed or close early due to inclement weather.

All events scheduled for the morning when schools are closed or the opening is delayed, i.e. before-school care or open houses, will be cancelled. Breakfasts are not served at school on days when BCPS delays opening.

If BCPS cancels its afterschool programs and events due to inclement weather, there will be no afterschool events at CNH, including aftercare.”

Abridged Version: CNH closes or delays corresponding with Baltimore CITY Public Schools. Listen to the radio, watch the local news/weather channels, or visit your favorite local weather/news websites. We recommend signing up for school closing/delay text alerts provided by local television or radio stations. WJZ is one who offers this service: <http://baltimore.cbslocal.com/school-closings-text-alerts>.

Every attempt is made to post snow closings and delays on the school FB page, however, that page is managed by volunteers who may or may not be awake as early as 5 AM (when BCPS makes their decision to close or delay). The quickest way to get accurate information on school closings and delays is via local television, radio, or websites.
