Kindergarten Supply List

Thank you for making the commitment to purchase school supplies. In kindergarten, the growth that children experience as individuals is complemented by the development of their identities as contributing, considerate members of a larger group. One way that we cultivate this sort of development is by sharing many classroom materials and supplies in common. Thus, as you and your child prepare the school supplies listed below, you will notice that I request that some items be labeled with your child's name, and some not.

Please label these items with your child's first and last name:

- 1 sketch book (spiral bound, unlined white paper, 100 sheets, 8½x11", any brand)
- 3 wide-ruled marble-cover composition book (any brand)
- 3 heavy-duty plastic pocket folders (one bottom pocket on each side) in the following colors: 1 red, 1 yellow, 1 blue
- 1 backpack
- 1 small blanket (for example, crib-sized) for rest time
- 1 complete change of clothes to keep at school throughout the year, including: underwear, socks, shoes, pants or skirt, and shirt. (Important: please label each item of clothing with your child's name and seal in a large Ziploc bag.)
- 1 water bottle

Please do not label these items:

- 2 packs of 20 thin Crayola Supertips Washable Markers
- 2 packs of thick Crayola Washable Markers
- 1 pack of 24 sharpened color pencils (Crayola or Scholastic brand)
- 4 packs clear "Scotch" tape **refill** roles, any brand
- 3 rolls masking tape (any brand)
- 1 box unscented tissues (any brand)
- 1 pump-dispenser of liquid hand soap (any brand)
- 1 pack plastic sheet protectors
- 1 ream of copy paper
- 1 pack thick black white board markers, Expo brand
- 1 pack thin white board markers, any color, Expo brand
- Children with last names A-G: 1 pack **flair tip** colored pens (such as Paper Mate)
- Children with last names H-Z: 1 pack **flair tip** black pens (such as Paper Mate)

Throughout the year, we invite families to contribute to art experiences by donating interesting materials that are no longer needed at your home or workplace but might inspire creativity in the classroom. You can drop off these materials in the kindergarten classroom at any time, starting on the first day of school. We hope you'll consider what you might have on hand at home or work to offer. A few ideas include: used but attractive papers, such as old gift wrap, colorful tissue paper, or origami paper; unused stationery and envelopes; old car maps and atlases; old flower nursery catalogs for cutting; silk or dried flowers; small items such as buttons, beads, colored metal bottle caps, nuts, and bolts in silver, brass, or copper colors, corks.

- 24 Ticonderoga TriWrite No 2 Pencils, SHARPENED (if you cannot find TriWrite pencils- not My First or regular pencils- please do not purchase)
- 4 Heavy Duty Plastic Pocket Folders (one bottom pocket on each side) in the following colors: red, blue, green, yellow
- 1 package Thick Washable Markers (classic colors) (Last names A-L)
- 1 package Thin Washable Markers (classic colors) (Last names M-Z)
- 1 box of gallon-sized ziplock bags (Last names A-L)
- 1 box of quart-sized ziplock bags (Last names M-Z)
- 1 box of colored pencils (Prang or Crayola)
- 3 packages of glue sticks
- 3 rolls of scotch tape
- 1 deck of playing cards
- 3 Pentel (white) erasers

- 1 pocket folder, your choice of color/design (this will be your home folder)
- 1 composition book
- 3 spiral 1-subject notebooks with pocket, wide rule
- 1 one-inch three ring binder
- 1 pack of subject dividers
- 1 index card case (for 3"x 5" index cards)

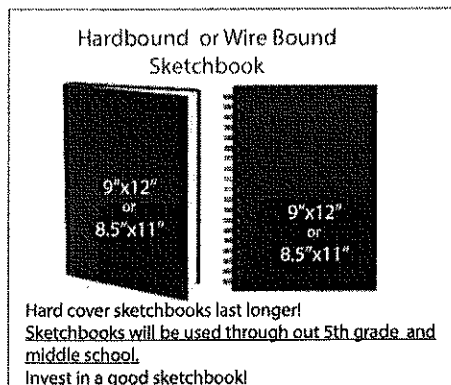
Class Materials: (These will be stored in the class and shared with all students.)

- 1 pack quart-size storage bags

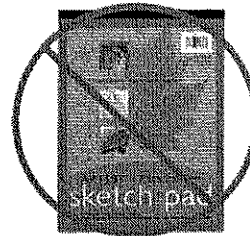

Please do not purchase a SKETCH PAD.

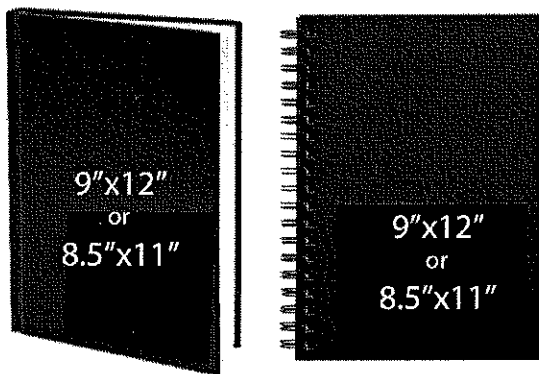
Sketchpads fall apart really easily and are designed to rip paper out rather than keep assignments bound together.

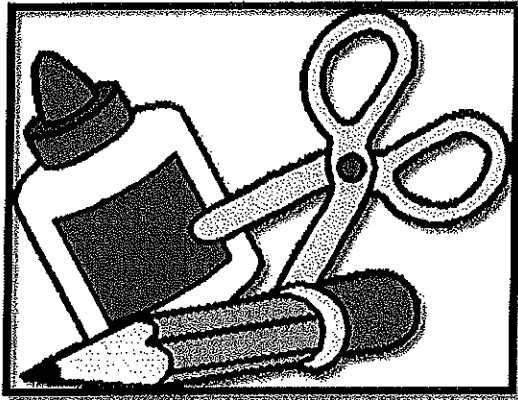
