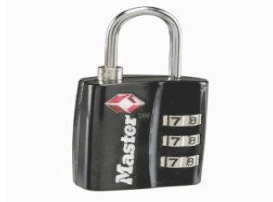


Fourth and Fifth Grade Student Supply List – Mrs. McGarvey and Mrs. Smiley

- Because students will be changing classes this year, they will have lockers to store their belongings. Because the school **WILL NOT** be providing locks, we strongly encourage that students purchase a **3-dial combination lock** (see picture below) to secure their items because the lockers will be located in the hallway and not inside the classrooms. **Please note that the locks MUST have 3 separate dials (single-lock dials will NOT be permitted) for ease of use. We are asking that students bring the locks in an unopened package so that Mrs. McGarvey and Mrs. Smiley can keep the lock code in a locked and secure place so that we can retrieve the code if a student cannot remember their code.**



Please note the 3-number dial on the right of the lock. This will help students be able to open their locks quicker and more easily.

- 10 heavy-duty, two-pocket folders that are laminated or are made of heavy plastic. The folders should have two pockets on the bottom—one on each side. We ask that you get solid colors for the folders below. Each folder should be labeled at the top of the outside cover with the student's name and grade. Because students will be switching classes and having a locker, having the correctly-colored and labeled folders will greatly assist the students when they are getting to know these new procedures:
 - 2 - red folders
 - 2 - blue folders
 - 2- green folders
 - 2- yellow folders
 - 2- purple folders
 - A homework folder will be provided for the students and will be used as their homework folder for both classes.
- Spiral notebooks, labeled with student name and grade on the outside cover. Each notebook should be at least 60 pages
 - 1- yellow notebook
 - 1 - red notebook
 - 2 - blue notebooks
 - 2- green notebooks
- 1 marble composition notebook
- 30 no. 2 pencils – Ticonderoga
- 1 pencil bag
- 1 pack erasers, either cap erasers or white/gummy erasers. (Please, **NO** pink erasers)
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 box tissues
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 1 package of colored pencils, 10 in a pack
- 5 dry erase markers or Crayola dry erase crayons
- 1 tray watercolors with paintbrush
- 4 packs of 3x3 post-its
- Boys: 1 box gallon-sized storage bags, 1 12-oz bottle hand sanitizer, 1 pack lined loose leaf paper, 4x6 index cards
- Girls: 1 box sandwich-sized baggies that are able to snap closed, 1 12-oz bottle of antibacterial soap, 1 ream plain white copier paper, 3x5 index cards
