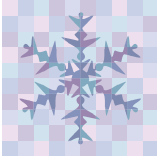

## **Sweet Fundraiser!**

We are very excited to announce a great opportunity to raise money to support our school. We will be selling sweet treats that most of us love: cinnamon rolls, carrot cakes, and cinnamon-nut twists! Here's how it works:

- The fundraiser begins today, 11/9, and extends through 11/30.
- We are selling large individual cinnamon rolls and carrot cakes (\$4) and family packs of cinnamon rolls and cinnamon-nut twists (\$13). The rolls and cakes are good for up to 7 days at room temperature after receipt or up to 7 months after freezing. Do not refrigerate.
- Included in this Monday Mailer is an order form and tips for selling. Please talk to family and friends to promote the fundraiser and secure orders.
- We are asking that every family try to sell a minimum of 24 items (the items range from \$4 to \$13) to help our school meet its goal. We will however happily accept orders less or more than 24 item target! Every sale counts! Additional sales are always appreciated!
- We prefer cash, but checks are acceptable and should be made payable to City Neighbors Hamilton.
- Please gather orders and submit them on Monday, November 30. We will accept orders earlier for families that will not be at school on that day.
- On 11/30 and 12/1, we will total sales, place our order, and then provide the exact delivery date to the school. We expect delivery to be between December 16th and December 22nd—just in time for those holiday gatherings!
